#### **Annual Meeting held in Vernon**

SWRE members from across the co-op's two-state service territory met in Vernon on August 9 for the organization's 2018 annual meeting. The event was held at the Wilbarger Auditorium.

Throughout that day many SWRE members enjoyed exhibits featuring the SWRE app, Operation Round Up and Western Farmers Electric Cooperative.

Prior to the brief business meeting, The Southwest Pride Barbershop Chorus dazzled the audience with their musical ensemble.

Youth Tour students, Deanna Duensing, a senior at Electra High School, and Timothy Jacobson, a senior at Snyder High School, were recognized as the 2018 Youth Tour winners.

SWRE CEO, Ken Simmons recognized several employee milestones and spoke about the early success of Operation Round Up. Simmons also recognized the couple in attendance who has been married the longest, which was Willie and Virginia Kieschnick, who have been married for 65 years.

Co-op attorney Loyd Benson led a brief business meeting. A quorum was present for conducting business. A total of 370 voting memberships were represented at the meeting.

High point of the annual event, as always, was a prize drawing. One hundred two prizes were given away, including +\$3,150 in energy certificates, smart home accessories and over \$2000 worth of donations from SWRE's vendor companies.

The reserve grand prize was a \$500 energy credit, won by member Carolyn Gibson and the grand prize, a 50-inch VIZIO 4K HD television, was won by Jane Ellis, an SWRE member.

### Johnita's Chocolate Chip Blonde Brownies



#### **Ingredients:**

- 2/3 cup melted butter 2 cups brown sugar
- 2 beaten eggs
- 2 tsp. vanilla
- 2 cups flour
- 1 tsp salt

1 tsp baking powder 1/4 tsp baking soda 1 cup chopped pecans (optional)

1 pkg chocolate chips

#### **Instructions:**

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees.
- 2. Mix together butter, brown sugar, eggs and vanilla.
- 3. Beat in the flour, salt, baking powder and baking soda.
- 4. Stir in chopped pecans.
- 5. Pour into a greased 9 x 13 pan and sprinkle chocolate chips over the top.
- 6. Bake for 25 minutes.
