## OPERATION ROUND UP GRANT DEADLINE APPROACHING

The SWRE Charitable Foundation is now accepting applications for the 2019 Operation Round Up. Applications and grant guidelines can be found online at SWRE.com/RoundUp.

Applications are due by September 3, 2019.

### WHAT IS OPERATION ROUND UP?

Operation Round Up gives SWRE members an opportunity to help out their neighbors. Members may round up their electric bills to the nearest dollar amount (an average of 50 cents per month). This change is accumulated and then given back in lump sums to charitable organizations who meet grant qualifications and guidelines. The program is administered by the SWRE Charitable Foundation Board made up of community leaders who establish the policies for granting Operation Round Up funds.

### **HOW WILL THE FUNDS BE USED?**

Operation Round Up funds stay right here in the SWRE service area. Funds are never used for political or administrative purposes. Operation Round Up does NOT help individuals or families with electric bills. The program serves the needs of five categories of assistance: communities, education and youth, senior citizens, emergency assistance and individuals impacted by a catastrophic event.

### "BOB'S" AWARD-WINNING CHILI



#### **INGREDIENTS:**

1 lb ground beef for chili 12 oz H-E-B Chorizo Sausage, uncooked

- 1 lb beef cubes, 3/8-inch fine-diced (caldillo)
- 1 medium onion, chopped 1 fresh poblano chile, seeds removed, minced
- 2 fresh jalapeno chiles, seeds removed, minced
- 6 large cloves garlic, minced
- 3 Tbsp Hill Country Fare Chili Powder
- 2 Tsp kosher salt
- 2 Tsp ground cumin
- 2 Tsp ground black pepper ½ Tsp cayenne pepper 2 cups H-E-B Beef Broth
- 14 ½ oz crushed tomatoes 8 oz tomato sauce

Source: This recipe was used by Bob Reid, our technology and facilities manager, to win our last SWRE Employee Chili Cookoff Contest. The recipe and photo can be found on H-E-B's website under the name "South Texas Three Meat Chili."

#### **DIRECTIONS:**

Place skillet over medium-high heat, squeeze chorizo from casings into a large skillet, add ground beef.

Stir, breaking meat into small crumbles with cooking spoon.

Cook beef and chorizo 6-8 minutes or until beef is no longer pink.

Add ground meat mixture, chili powder, salt, pepper, cumin and cayenne, stir to combine.

Place cubed beef in a 6-quart pot over medium-high heat with onion, chiles and garlic, brown 6-8 minutes or until beef is no longer pink.

Add ground meat mixture, chili powder, salt, pepper, cumin and cayenne, stir to combine, cook 2 minutes.

Stir in beef broth, tomatoes and tomato sauce, bring to a boil; cover pot and reduce heat to low.

Simmer gently 50 minutes, stirring occasionally.
