CONTEST RULES

The Youth Power Energy Camp Essay Contest is open to any eighth grade student who lives or attends school within the SWRE service area. Students who are the child or grandchild of a current SWRE employee or trustee are NOT eligible to enter. Students MUST be available to attend camp May 31-June 3, 2022 and have confirmed their availability with parents, coaches, church groups, club leaders or anyone else that makes decisions about their life. Students will be expected to follow health and safety protocols at camp.

HOW TO ENTER

Thoughtfully write an original essay on the topic below. Turn in your essay and entry form online at <u>SWRE.com/Energy-Camp</u> by Tuesday, March 1, 2022.

ESSAY TOPIC: Should electric lineman be considered first responders? Why or why not?

ESSAY FORMAT

The essay must be original and of 350 to 500 words. It must be typewritten on white 8 1/2" x 11" paper. No name may appear on the body of the essay. All participant information can be completed on the entry form. All essays submitted become the property of SWRE and will not be returned.

JUDGING

An independent judge will review the entries for creativity, originality, accuracy, organization, grammatical correctness, style and content. The judge will select eight finalists from Texas and Oklahoma and select the top two essays (one from Oklahoma and one from Texas).

PRIZES AWARDED

At least eight finalists will receive a \$50 cash prizes. The top two essay authors will win an all-expenses paid trip to Energy Camp.* Participating teachers will receive a \$50 classroom donation (limit one per teacher)!

*In the event that OAEC cancels Energy Camp due to the COVID-19 pandemic, alternate prizes will be awarded to the authors of the top two essays.
