

## **2023 SWRE Youth Tour** Application Instructions

# <u>NOTE</u>: You will upload the completed items into your online application at <u>SWRE.COM/YOUTHTOUR</u>. You will need a student and parent/guardian signature to apply.

Applications are OPEN from October 1 to December 1. The 2023 SWRE Youth Tour Application has 4 components:

- 1) COMMUNITY PROJECT BUSINESS PLAN (~20 minutes to complete)
- 2) LEGISLATIVE LETTER (~20 minutes to complete)
- 3) COOPERATIVE DIFFERENCE VIDEO (~15 minutes to complete)
- 4) STUDENT PHOTO & GENERAL INFO (~5 minutes to complete)

(Approximate completion times are based on an applicant who has previewed the application instructions and prepared potential concepts for the three portions of the application. Applicants who have fully prepared ideas and supporting information for the three sections can likely finish the online application in ~15 minutes.)

COOPERATIVE: an autonomous association of persons united voluntarily to meet their common economic, social and cultural needs and aspirations through a jointly-owned and democratically-controlled enterprise.

The cooperative business model was created in the 1800s on the values of self-help, self-responsibility, equality, equity, democracy and solidarity. With those values in mind, today co-ops operate under the **7 Cooperative Principles:** 

- 1. Voluntary & Open Membership
- 2. Democratic Member Control
- 3. Member Economic Participation
- 4. Autonomy & Independence
- 5. Education, Training & Information
- 6. Cooperation Among Cooperatives
- 7. Commitment to Community
