Contest Rules, Application Instructions & Resume Template

The annual Youth Tour Contest is open to high school juniors living in or attending school in SWRE's service territory. This includes juniors in Altus, Blair, Chillicothe, Crowell, Electra, Frederick, Harrold, Navajo, Northside, Snyder, Tipton, and Vernon. Co-op membership is not required to enter the contest. *Children and grandchildren of SWRE board members are not eligible to apply.*

Applications are open from October 1 to December 15 and must be submitted online at **SWRE.com/YouthTour** by **December 15, 2025 at 11:59 p.m.**

The application has two components:

- 1) Submit a resume.
- 2) Submit a 1-2 minute video telling us why you want to go to Washington D.C.

Finalists Competition: Up to eight finalists will be selected to interview in front of a panel of independent judges on Wednesday, January 21 at SWRE headquarters in Tipton, OK. ***Participation in the interview is required to remain eligible for any of the prizes. *** Winners and parents will meet with SWRE's Youth Coordinator on February 25 to receive trip details and complete paperwork.

Prizes:

- Winners (one from Oklahoma and one from Texas): a week-long, all-expenses paid trip of a lifetime on Youth Tour in Washington D.C. in June
- All Finalists: \$250 cash prize after completing an interview
- Nominators: \$100 cash prize for each finalist you nominate that completes an interview

*Youth Tour Cancellation & Reimbursement Policy: Students selected and sponsored by Southwest Rural Electric Association, Inc. are expected to participate in required preparatory activities related to the Oklahoma and/or Texas Your Tour and the full duration of the student program, including group travel to and from Washington, D.C. The student experience has a program value of \$4,375 per participant. While cancellations are unfortunate, cancellations received/processed 90-days prior to the day of registration are appreciated and needed to allow cooperatives to find alternate student participants. Families of selected students who cancel less than 90-days prior to the day of registration, may be responsible for reimbursing the sponsoring cooperative up to 50% of the program value. No shows and families of selected students failing to notify Southwest Rural Electric Association, Inc. of nonparticipation may be held responsible for reimbursing 100% of the program value.
